Describe one problem your software solves. Write a useful checklist someone could apply without buying it. Find an actual permitted showcase route and record its rules, URL and observation date.

The worked contribution

I build an invoice follow-up app, and this is my contribution to the weekly showcase. Before sending another reminder, check three things: whether the invoice reached the right person, whether a purchase-order reference is missing, and whether the agreed payment date has actually passed. A useful first message asks which detail is blocking payment and gives the recipient an easy way to reply. What most often slows your invoices down?

What must be checked?

A real community may restrict research questions, links or AI-written material even in its showcase. Its actual rules and your account eligibility must be checked.
